




FEMA and FCC Plan Nationwide Emergency Alert Test for Oct. 4, 2023

During my presentation, at 2:20, for 30 minutes, FEMA will be sending out this nationwide emergency alert test. **Test Messages Will be Sent to All TVs, Radios and Cell Phones.** This may cause a loud noise to alert on every phone in the room, and the only way to *delay* a message is to have your phone **powered down or on airplane mode.** There is no guarantee that the message will be a loud noise, but in case it does I wanted to give people a chance now to power down or prepare for the possibility, as there are quite a few phones in the room that may be alerting.

BACKGROUND

CRIP THEORY

The blurring or merging of queer theory and critical disability studies. Crip theory explores how the social pressures and norms around ability intersect with the social pressures and norms around gender/sexuality.

NORMATIVITY

The phenomenon in human societies of designating some expectations of behavior, culture, and identity and often applying a morality to it that leaves deviations from the "norm" to be considered unexpected, uncommon, or unnatural.

INTERSECTIONALITY


The complex and cumulative way that the effects of different forms of discrimination (such as racism, sexism, and classism) combine, overlap, and intersect—especially in the experiences of marginalized people or groups.

AMATONORMATIVITY

The assumptions that a central, exclusive, amorous relationship is normal for humans, in that it is a universally shared goal, and that such a relationship is normative, in that it should be aimed at in preference to other relationship types.

INTERSECTIONALITY

- Cumulative
- Overlap in identity; overlap in disadvantage & discrimination
- The "why" behind DEIA- preventing a singular focus
- Intersections-race, age, body type, class, gender, origin, education +
